Range Safety

Members are reminded to **ENSURE** that all rounds impact the backstops. Targets that are placed close to the ground offer the chance for the rounds to ricochet over the backstops.

ALL ROUNDS MUST STAY INSIDE THE RANGE!!

All members are responsible for enforcing the range rules and safe gun handling practices. If you notice an unsafe act or condition, call "CEASE FIRE" and address the safety infraction. We are not encouraging confrontation. Usually a friendly reminder is all that is required.

Club T-Shirts

No Fully Automatic Weapons Allowed

During the annual meeting the question was asked if full auto weapons could be fired semi auto. This ban does not stop a member from firing a full auto weapon in the semi auto mode. It simply restricts firing full auto. The club membership needs to help enforce the new rule. We must police ourselves to ensure the safety of members, guest and neighbors. Also as a reminder, NO HARD TARGETS are allowed on the range with the following exceptions:

1. Approved silhouette targets being used in practice or matches.
2. Approved spinner type targets, used on the plinking range only and placed at the bottom of the berm. Do not place these targets midway between the berm and the firing line.
3. **DO NOT SHOOT CONCRETE BLOCKS!**

Guests

The Pensacola Rifle and Pistol Club has always had a rather liberal policy when it came to members bringing guest. Lately some members have begun to abuse the policy. Members are responsible for the conduct of their guests. That means that you are responsible for acting as a range safety officer when your guests are on the firing line. Make sure you are supervising his or her actions to ensure a safe firing line for everyone. Guests are required to be on the same firing line as the member. Don't allow your guest to shoot unsupervised on another range.

Lead Removal

The expended lead in the berms is free for taking if you want it. The only requirement is that you call Charlie Webster at 968-9846 and let him know how much lead you picked up and from what range. Charlie has to make a yearly report to the EPA and needs to know how much is removed.

Trash Reminder

Once you have concluded firing and are ready to pack up, don't forget to police the range of shot up cans and plastic bottles. Place these cans and bottles in the blue or white barrels beside the trashcans not the trashcans. We can still recycle cans and plastic bottles if they have holes in them. Remember that what goes in the trashcans will be burned. **DO NOT PUT MISFIRED ROUNDS OR SPENT BRASS IN THE TRASHCAN!** This is what the red boxes nailed to the post and buckets are for. Everyone that has had experience burning trash at the range can tell you about the rounds cooking off when burned. Some have even been hit by flying shrapnel. The five gallon buckets hanging on the post or sitting on the ground are for your spent brass. Also remember to sweep up your brass from the firing line. Brooms and dustpans are provided at each range for this purpose.
