## Range Safety

Members are reminded to **ENSURE** that all rounds impact the backstops. Targets that are placed close to the ground offer the chance for the rounds to ricochet over the backstops.

**ALL ROUNDS MUST STAY INSIDE THE RANGE!!**

All members are responsible for enforcing the range rules and safe gun handling practices. If you notice an unsafe act or condition, call "CEASE FIRE" and address the safety infraction. We are not encouraging confrontation. Usually a friendly reminder is all that is required.

### Range Safety Meetings

The Board of Directors has recognized a growing need for safety training. The club will begin conducting Range Safety Meetings for **ALL** members. Members will be required to attend one meeting during the year as a condition for membership renewal the following year. Meetings have been scheduled for the 5 September, 3 October, and the 6 November at the Family Life Center of Pine Forest United Methodist Church, 2800 Wilde Lake Blvd. The meeting will start at 7pm. All members who have not attended as of yet are encouraged to make one of these meetings.

### Trash Reminder

Use the blue or white barrels beside the trashcans for cans and plastic bottles. We recycle these items because they don't burn. Remember that all trash that goes in the trashcans will be burned. **DO NOT put misfired rounds or spent brass in the trashcan!** This is what the red boxes nailed to the post are for (I pulled 28 live 22lr rounds out of a trashcan on the pistol range a week or so ago). Everyone that has had experience burning trash at the range can tell you about the rounds cooking off when burn. Some have even been hit by flying shrapnel. The five gallon buckets hanging on the post or sitting on the ground are for your spent brass. Also remember to sweep up your brass from the firing line. Brooms and dustpans are provided at each range for this purpose.

## Tired of searching for a useable target frame at the Range?

This is a simple easy to make your own target stand that is easily transported and stowed. I made this from 1 ½" PVC pipe. The pieces extending from the center are approx 10" long. The vertical pieces are 6-8 inches. The pieces that don't have the verticals attached are not glued so they can be removed for easier transport. Everything else is glued. The stand is 29" outside to outside of the uprights. This makes the 1X2 uprights that are used to attach the cardboard backers exactly the right width. I drilled a 1/4 " hole close to the end of each leg so that a 6-8 inch nail could be driven through each leg for added stability. This whole setup cost less than \$20.00 including the 1x2's and took about 30 minutes to construct.
